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16 A BILL

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21 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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26 To designate the bridge on Connecticut Avenue NW, located between Devonshire Place NW and
27 Macomb Street NW, as the Judith E. Heumann Memorial Bridge.

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29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
30 act may be cited as the “Judith E. Heumann Memorial Bridge Designation Act of 2025”.

31 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 422 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition
32 Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-
33 204.01 and 9-204.22), the Council designates the bridge on Connecticut Avenue NW, located
34 between Devonshire Place NW and Macomb Street NW, as depicted on the plat in the committee
35 report, as the “Judith E. Heumann Memorial Bridge”.

36 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

37 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
38 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
39 approved October 16, 2006 (12 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

40 Sec. 4. Effective date.

41 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
42 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto) and a 30-day period of congressional review
43 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
44 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-206(c)(1)).
